



## Euthanasia of Livestock Training Course

The welfare of animals is a Dairy Industry priority and the humane killing of cattle that are sick or injured is something that dairy farmers are required to deal with as part of good animal husbandry. It is important that all steps are taken to work within the law, meet the high industry and community expectations and most importantly, to deliver the best animal welfare outcomes.

The “Euthanase Livestock” course is an accredited program supported by Dairy Australia and DairyTas. The course is delivered by an approved trainer with the support of our NCDE partner TasTAFE. The accredited training covers all legal methods for humane destruction of livestock and provides practical instruction on the use of captive bolt devices, with a focus on operator safety and animal welfare. It also covers use, maintenance and storage of equipment used to euthanase livestock and methods for carcass disposal.

This small group training program is very practical and contains many principles that can be immediately applied on farm. As the number of participants in the course are restricted we recommend booking early to avoid disappointment.
