Euthanasia of Livestock Training Course

This includes when we need to euthanase sick or injured animals.

- ALL legal methods for humane destruction of livestock
- Practical instruction on the use of captive bolt devices, with a focus on operator safety and animal welfare.
- Maintenance and storage of all equipment used to euthanase livestock and
- Methods for carcass disposal.

This small group training program is very practical and contains many principles that can be immediately applied on farm.
