



Financial Literacy for Dairy Farmers Course

Commencing March 1 take this opportunity to gain greater financial management skills for your dairy business.

In this course you will learn about how to analyse, organise, and report on your financial activities, report for tax compliance, undertake a breakeven and sensitivity analysis, and develop a financial plan for your farm.

At the end of the program you will have:

- ✓ A cash ledger & chart of accounts using your own farm data
- ✓ A cash flow statement using your own farm data
- ✓ A financial plan & finance proposal for your farm
